

Extensibility as a double-edged sword








Addressing the elephant in the room

The issues

- Individual / single vendor
- Question of ownership
- Rather than consolidate,
 we want to win
- No feedback mechanism, unless something's broken


Over 3/4 of unpaid maintainers would prefer to get paid



Maintenance work is work

 Developing in step with Postgres versions is non-trivial as a solo dev





The CRA might make us care

- Cyber Resilience Act is coming for all of us
- A PMC of 1 can't meet the requirements of the CRA, you'd be irresponsible placing your project onto the market
- Definition tbd: a makefile, making your software available through package managers, writing release notes, etc, signaling a healthy project, vs a hobby script you threw on GitHub

Extension Ecosystem Summit


